PTECH College Courses

PTAA is the only 2018-19 Charter school with PTECH Accreditation. PTECH has MOU signed with UT Arlington, All Dallas County Colleges and is currently working with UTD, SMU, Concordia University and Mayville State University to provide dual credit courses to PTAA students and allow students to graduate with an Associate Degree as well as a High School Diploma. PTAA's industry partnerships allow students to take 1-2 year technology internships in high school.

The Latin Language will also be an elective subject. A foundation in Latin allows for an easier understanding of other languages.

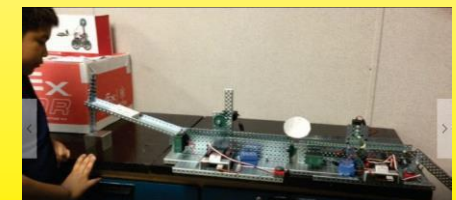
Foreign Leadership Programs
