

2019-2020 Dress Code – Greenville Campus

Monday – Formal Uniforms

- > Navy Blazer with PTAA emblem (boys and girls) *Available at PTAA office
- > White Oxford (button-up) shirt (boys and girls)
- > Tie (green, navy, gold plaid) (boys and girls) *Available at PTAA office
- > Khaki Trousers (no cargo, no joggers, no stretchy leggings)
- Khaki or Plaid (green, navy, gold plaid) Skirt (for girls). Skirts & shorts must be long enough to maintain modesty while sitting and standing. Students must wear shorts under their skirts at all times.
- > Belt (brown or black solid color) preferred for middle school & high school
- > Brown or black dress shoes (non-scuff)- preferred

Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday - Standardized Uniform

- > Solid Navy, Hunter Green, or White polo or PTAA polo
- > Khaki, Navy, or Black trousers (no cargo, no joggers, no leggings) OR
- Khaki, Navy, or Black long shorts / skirts Skirts & shorts must be long enough to maintain modesty while sitting and standing. Students must wear shorts under their skirts at all times.
- > Belt (brown or black solid color) preferred for middle school & high school
- > Tennis shoes (cannot scuff the floor) (no slides or flip flops, sandals)

<u>Friday – Casual Uniform</u>

- > Jeans (no rips, no holes, no sagging, no leggings) **OR**
- Jean shorts (no cutoffs, no rips, no holes, no sagging) shorts must be long enough to maintain modesty while sitting and standing.
- > PTAA school t-shirt / PTAA polo OR
- Standardized Uniform
- > Tennis shoes (cannot scuff the floor) (no slides or flip flops, sandals)

No hats - No distracting headbands - No face painting - No hoodies

- Only solid black, brown, or navy tights may be worn under garments.
- Only a solid black zip up jacket with no hood may be worn during class time.
